

TRANSFER CONDITIONS BOYNE RIVER & TARONG WATER SUPPLY

MAKING WATER WORK

These local transfer conditions are to be read in conjunction with the conditions as set out on the Temporary Transfer Application Form.

Loss Adjustments

Under normal conditions there are no loss adjustments for the scheme. SunWater will advise applicants if a loss adjustment will be required.

Trading Caps

As per the Burnett Basin ROP a water allocation holder may apply for a seasonal assignment/change to the location of the water allocation between zones LA and KA.

The proposed seasonal change is not a permitted change if the proposed change would result in a use of medium or high priority water allocations in excess of the cap limitations provided by Department of Environment and Resource Management, as indicated in the below table; current as at April 2010 (subject to change):

Table 1: Permitted use of high priority water allocation in the Boyne River and Tarong WSS by zone

Table 2: Permitted use of medium priority water allocation in the Boyne River and Tarong WSS by zone

Capacity Constraints

Additional supply and capacity constraints will apply for requests to access water from the pipeline system, for both HP and MP transfer requests. SunWater reserves the right to refuse a transfer if accepting the transfer may cause supply issues to existing customers.

Note: Transfers between zones may be subject to a longer approval process due to necessary legal referral processes relating to existing contractual obligations in the KA zone.

Transfer Adjustment Fee

A Transfer Adjustment Fee, equal to the value of SunWater's applied irrigation price subsidy, will be payable where water is transferred from a regulated irrigation pricing use to a non-irrigation use. It is the responsibility of the parties to any such transfer to contact SunWater to ascertain this fee in advance of settlement.

Storage Charges Fee

Storage Charges Fees may be applicable in this scheme.

Other

Additional restrictions on temporary transfers may be applied, for example, in extremely dry conditions or when there is a marked transfer of water to high loss areas, at SunWater's discretion.
