

Start of water year Announced Allocations

Eton WSS Prediction Graph as at 1 April

Purpose

This prediction graph has been calculated using the water sharing rules in the Eton Water Supply Scheme (WSS) Operations Manual. It can be used as a tool to assist customers in providing an indication of what the Announced Allocations may look like at the start of the water year.

How the prediction graph works

- You will need to access the current storage volume of Kinchant Dam, which can be found at this link: https://storagelevels.sunwater.com.au/win/reports/win_storages.htm
- Use the current storage volume or an approximate forecast storage volume for 1 April in the “Scheme Storage Capacity” axis on the graph and find the corresponding “Start of Water Year Announced Allocation” percentage.
- For example, if the storage volume was 31,400 ML the predicted Announced Allocations on 1 April would be High Priority 100% and Medium Priority 30%.

Important points

- Many variables can influence these predictions. If you rely on the predicted Announced Allocations for any purpose, you do so at your own risk.
- From 1 April, Sunwater will calculate the actual start of water year Announced Allocations using the volume held in storage at the time and publish the announcements accordingly.
