Nogoa Mackenzie Carryover Application –Conditions

General

Carryover enables customers to carry over unused available water at the end of a Water Year to become available in the next Water Year within the limits and subject to the conditions and rules below.

Any Riparian Allowance is deemed to be the first water used through offtakes, prior to any Carryover water used.

Application

To apply for Carryover please complete and sign this application form and submit it to SunWater.

Applications for Carryover must be received not less than 2 working days prior to the end of the water year.

Carryover does not alter the customer's peak flow rate or roster conditions.

Carryover is only available to customers who are metered by SunWater.

Outstanding Accounts

This application will not be assessed by SunWater unless you have settled any outstanding accounts.

If you are unsure whether you have any outstanding accounts and wish to avoid unnecessary delays, please contact SunWater Customer Support on 13 15 89 prior to submitting this application.

Ongoing Carryover

By nominating the ongoing Carryover facility, the total of the customer's NAW will be available. SunWater and or the customer can end an ongoing Carryover arrangement at any time by advising the other party in writing. The change will take effect from the commencement of the new Water Year.

Net Available Water (NAW)

This is the water balance at the end of the Water Year after adjustment for the Scheme Cap rule and the subsequent reduction of the volume for the Loss Factor.

Temporary Transfer

Customers intending to temporary transfer water need to be aware that the Net Carryover Volume can be cancelled under Point 2 of the Cancellation Rule.

Temporary Transfer of Carryover water can only be processed from Carryover Water Account to Carryover Water Account.

Maximum Volume of Carryover & Storage Losses

The maximum volume that can be carried over and the losses to be applied for the scheme are shown in the table below:

If the volumes applied for exceed the cap, individual carryover volumes will be reduced proportionately.

Cancellation Rule

The Carryover arrangements for the Water Year cease:

1. At the end of the water year (30 June); or
 2. when Fairbairn Dam commences to spill and then;
- At the end of the water year customers may provide current meter readings to SunWater for all outlets within 48 hours of the end of the water year.
 - Customers must provide current meter readings for all outlets within 48 hours of the spill beginning.
 - All water usage will be allocated against Net Carryover Volume.
 - All unused Net Carryover Volume at 30 June or beginning of the spill event will be cancelled.
