TEMPORARY TRANSFER CHDV – TRANSFER CONDITIONS

1. What is a temporary transfer of Channel Harvesting Diversion Volume (CHDV).

A temporary transfer enables two customers to transfer CHDV in the current water year.

The seller's remaining CHDV for the water year will be reduced by the Nominated CHDV Transfer Volume. The CHDV available to the buyer will be increased by this volume

Temporary transfers do not alter the buyer or seller's access conditions for taking CHDV from a channel or pipeline.

2. Volume that can be transferred

The maximum amount the seller may transfer is the volume available to the seller at the time of application. By signing this form, the seller warrants they have sufficient CHDV available for the temporary transfer.

The Seller is to provide a meter reading at time of application to determine if such CHDV is available.

Available CHDV balances are available from the St. George Office.

If the Seller applies to transfer more than their available CHDV, they will be in breach of their supply contract with SunWater.

3. Application

To apply for a transfer, the buyer and seller should complete and sign this application form and submit it to their local SunWater Office.

Please ensure the application form is submitted at least five (5) business days prior to the end of the current water year.

SunWater will then notify the buyer and seller in writing within 5 business days of receiving this application form (correctly completed) whether the temporary transfer has been approved or refused. The Local Conditions applying to your application will be the Local Conditions in place on the day your application is received by SunWater. Details of the current Local Conditions can be obtained by contacting your local SunWater Business Centre.

You should contact SunWater prior to signing the application form to ensure you have a current version of the application form. Your application will not be assessed by SunWater unless you have used the most up-to-date version of the application form.

WARNING

- Any transfer of money between the buyer and the seller is made at their own risk.
- The buyer should not begin accessing the CHDV from a temporary transfer until they receive the written confirmation from SunWater that the temporary transfer has been approved and permitted offtakes and delivery conditions are advised. If a buyer exceeds its existing agreement and the temporary transfer is refused, the buyer will be required to rectify overuse from allocation water
- Water to be delivered under transferred CHDV will only be delivered when the channel system has capacity as no Channel Harvesting Peak Flow entitlement will be attributed to the transferred CHDV.

4. Supply Contract

The buyer must have a supply contract with SunWater for delivery of the CHDV and all accounts must be current.

Where the seller may have an arrangement with SunWater for payment of outstanding charges, SunWater may approve the transfer subject to these proceeds being paid to SunWater to reduce the outstanding amount. You can check your balance if you are registered with SunWaterOnline.

5. Water Charges

The seller's CHDV Lease Fee charges do not change as a result of the temporary transfer.

Part B consumption charges will be applied to Channel Harvesting Diversion Volume at the point of take.

6. Approved of Pumps

The buyer must ensure they have obtained approval under the Integrated Planning Act for their pump. Only offtakes approved by SunWater can access CHDV.

7. Transportation Loss Adjustments

Loss adjustments for CHDV are listed in table 1 below.
