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Transfer Statement:

The Purchaser and Seller agree to the terms outlined on this form.

The Seller agrees that if they are selling all of the Channel Harvesting Diversion Volume subject to a contract, then this is an application to terminate that Water Supply Contract.

The Purchaser further acknowledges that SunWater may need to apply conditions in relation to distribution losses associated and delivery constraints associated with the delivery of additional water into the channel system.

Guidelines and Conditions

**NOTICE OF APPLICATION – PERMANENT TRANSFER OF
CHANNEL HARVESTING DIVERSION VOLUME (CHDV)
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Application – Permanent Transfer CHDV

This application must be signed by the purchaser and seller. Please attach a copy of the Sale Contract for the CHDV to enable SunWater to verify the entities involved.

Amending the Purchaser’s Contract – Permanent Transfer CHDV

SunWater will send a new contract to the purchaser for them to sign prior to water being taken under this permanent transfer of CHDV.

Amending the Seller’s Contract – Permanent Transfer CHDV.

If the seller is selling all their CHDV subject to a contract, then SunWater will release the Seller from their Contracts after:

- A Channel Harvesting Diversion Contract approved and signed by SunWater has been received from the Purchaser
- Payout of any outstanding SunWater accounts is received

If only part of the Seller’s CHDV is being transferred, SunWater will amend the Seller’s contract to reflect the reduced CHDV upon the above conditions being met.

Water Charges – Permanent Transfer CHDV

The purchaser and seller are advised to deal with apportionment of water charges as part of settlement.

If a final meter reading is obtained then SunWater may issue a final invoice addressed to the seller. SunWater can provide a final meter reading for a fee or customers may choose to read the meter themselves and advise SunWater.

Flow Rates and Maximum Diversion Rates – Channel

Access conditions and maximum diversion rates will be assessed in accordance with local conditions and advised accordingly.

Channel Harvesting Peak Flow Entitlement will not be transferred as part of the permanent trade.

Water cannot be taken by the purchases until advised in writing by SunWater.

Distribution Losses in the Channel System

SunWater will consider the impacts on distribution losses from the transfer as part of this application and advise the Purchaser of loss requirements as per table 1 below.
