

**Minutes of the Nogo Mackenzie IAC Meeting held in Emerald on the
9th December 2011**

Meeting opened at 0945 at the SunWater Depot, 87 Esmond Street, Emerald.

Previous Minutes:

The draft minutes of the previous meeting on 11th of October 2011 were read.

Business Arising from Previous Minutes:

- 1. Bedford Weir Incident; Barry Jeppesen gave a brief summary of where this incident resolution was at, still to be heard in the Courts.**
- 2. Fairbairn dam Recreation area; Barry also gave a brief summary of what the SunWater intentions were for the future of the Recreation Area.**

New Business:

- 1. TCC: Barry Jeppesen gave the meeting a briefing on the condition of TCC on the Selma Channel. Barry intended to make a decision in 6 months time following the weekly monitoring of the TCC system reliability. He said that he would make an arbitrary decision of whether the TCC system would remain in operation or not.**

Barry introduced David Sobey from Rubicon who gave a summary of the TCC system and the problems which SunWater have experienced. David also ensured the Committee that Rubicon was here for full support of the TCC system and that the company was dedicated totally to make the system fully operational.

There was some further discussion from those present about the reliability of the TCC system and costs associated with the "Trial" and when it would cease to be a trial. BJ said that as his intention and that of SunWater was that the time of the trial is over and we will monitor availability and any faults on the system for the next 6 months and then a decision will be made by him.

- 2. Peak Flow Entitlements: Barry J spoke about the intent of PFE and what the original irrigation system was designed for. The original farms have Peak Flow Outlets etc. There was much discussion on this matter and some members thought that they should be able to sell their Peak Flow Entitlements. Barry said that more work had to be done on this subject by SunWater and it would be brought back to the Committee at the next IAC meeting.**

3. QCA/ Water Pricing:

Barry J also spoke on this matter and said that the QCA were still deciding on the whole issue of Water Pricing.

The meeting was closed at 1205pm and the Chairman thanked all persons for attending.
