SunWater has built, operated, maintained and owned the pipeline and three major pump stations since construction in 1983.

The Tarong Pipeline supplies water from Boondooma Dam in the North to the Tarong Power Station in the South. It is 95 km in length, supplying 31,240 ML annually to the power station.

The pipeline includes a Tilapia fish screen to stop the spread of Tilapia to other catchments along the length of the pipeline.
