

Water Safety Lesson Plan

Below is a potential guide for a lesson in water safety – feel free to incorporate some other elements to tailor the program to the specific needs of your students.

1. Begin with a general discussion about water safety and ask the children what they think might be some hidden dangers around dams, weirs and water channels.
2. Produce the water safety posters and go through each of them with the class (these posters explain each piece of infrastructure and the related hidden dangers). NB You could perhaps start with introducing “Blue” the water drop by using the posters, to set the scene for his involvement in the learning session
3. Play the DVD
4. Hand out the A4 leaflet and read together as a class
5. Hand out the sheet game and get the students to complete it – good form of recap for the learning session
6. Also take advantage of the colouring-in sheets (available on the website) – perhaps students could complete these and they could be posted on classroom walls
7. Complete the evaluation form and send it back to us
