

# Invisible Hazards (Y4-Y6)

Lesson: Invisible Hazards (Y4-Y6)	
Age Group (Grades): 4-6	Lesson duration: Approx. 20 mins
<b>Aim:</b> Students understand the types of risks associated with 'invisible hazards' in different water bodies and are able to make safe decisions.	
<b>Notes</b>	
This activity is to expand the student's understanding of 'invisible hazards'. This activity includes student-led discussion on activities that can lead to a hazard and how to avoid them or be safe around them.	
<b>Instructions</b>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The presenter will provide students with materials for an image reveal paper-based activity.</li> <li>2. Students will start customizing their infrastructure by cutting, coloring, and placing hazards on the 'infrastructure map' provided.</li> <li>3. Students will present their infrastructure to class by revealing their design and discussing/describing information about the hazards they found, explain the location of the hazards and provide reasoning as to why they were placed there.</li> <li>4. With the help of the presenter, students can discuss/describe information about the hazards (i.e. how they might come across it and how to avoid it safely).</li> </ol>
