

# Interactive Story (P-Y3)

Lesson: Interactive Story (P-Y3)	
Age Group (Grades): P-3	Lesson duration: Approx. 15 minutes
<b>Aim:</b> Students understand how to enjoy water infrastructure safely through a simulated trip to a dam.	
<b>Notes</b>	
This activity is a highly interactive story between students and the presenter to be done in a 'choose your own adventure' style where the presenter proposes scenarios for the students to respond to.	
<b>Instructions</b>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The presenter will introduce a story about visiting a dam, using images on a projector to aid the story.</li> <li>2. Throughout the story, the presenter will introduce examples of scenarios where safety must be considered.</li> <li>3. The presenter will incite discussion from the students on how to approach the hazard. For example, 'While walking on the path, you notice unstable ground up ahead next to the body of water. What should we do?' As a class, students will vote and decide on the best action and the outcome of the story will be decided by them.</li> <li>4. As the presenter continues with the story, different relevant photos will be shown on the projector so the students can see the hazards.</li> <li>5. Once the interactive story is finished, the presenter will lead a discussion with the students on what they learnt on how to deal with unsafe situations around a dam.</li> </ol>
