

Invisible Hazards - Mystery Boxes (P-Y3)

Lesson: Invisible Hazards - Mystery Boxes (P-Y3)	
Age Group (Grades): P-3	Lesson duration: Approx. 10-15 mins
Aim: Students understand the types of risks associated with 'invisible hazards' in different water bodies and are able to make safe decisions.	
Notes	
This activity is to expand the student's understanding of 'invisible hazards'. This activity includes student-led discussion on activities that can lead to a hazard and how to avoid them or make safe choices around them.	
Instructions	
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The presenter will provide a touch and feel box, with 4 different items/ materials that represent each hazard from the following list:<ol style="list-style-type: none">a) Rocksb) Trees/Stumps/Logsc) Algae/Slimed) Vines/Weeds2. Each student will approach the box, close their eyes, and guess what the materials are.3. With the help of the presenter, students can identify that we can not see all risks.4. As a class the facilitator will discuss some specific scenarios, highlight the risks and how the students can avoid them.
