

Important Safety Notice: Water Storage Hazards

Sunwater is proactively reducing Paradise Dam's capacity to facilitate essential work to lower the spillway.

As the water level reduces, please be aware of water storage hazards.

Paradise Dam, Mingo Crossing and waterways within the catchment may be subject to the following hazards:

- variable water levels
- weeds
- extremely cold water
- submerged obstacles
- floating debris
- strong and unpredictable currents



No person, boat or other vessel is permitted within 100m of a dam or weir wall or other structures.

All users of this water storage area should exercise due care and attention particularly at night. All boats and other vessels should be adequately illuminated.

Do not operate boats or other vessels in adverse weather conditions or at times of poor visibility.

Some areas of this property are shared with other users and contain native fauna and flora. You must use reasonable care to operate boats and other vessels safely so as to minimise the impact of these activities.

All persons on this property enter at their own risk, should exercise due care and attention and must comply with all signs, notices, the lawful directions of Sunwater, Sunwater staff, all laws, regulations and applicable standards (e.g. boating, fire, road usage).
