4	Project update
	An update was provided on project activities since the last meeting. Items discussed:
	• Sunwater is on track with the detailed business case (DBC) for the Burdekin Falls Dam
	Improvement and Raising projects. The DBC is anticipated to be completed and
	submitted to the Queensland Government by the end of the year. The DBC considers
	the necessary dam safety requirements and the potential opportunity to raise the
	dam wall to improve long-term water security in the Burdekin region.
	Ongoing site investigations – drilling on main spillway, geological mapping, and
	geotechnical investigations.
	Further clay borrow area test pits completed, lab results pending.
	Finalising the preliminary design report for the detailed business case.
	Modelling underway to assess and support safe fish passage.
	Recent field surveys completed:
	<ul> <li>Terrestrial ecology – studying the natural and existing upstream and</li> </ul>
	downstream movement and habitat requirements of terrestrial flora and fauna.
	o Geomorphology – assessing the sediment within waterways around the dam).
	o Groundwater – examining groundwater quality, water levels, rates and volumes
	of usage and registered bore condition.
