	contractors who will be undertaking the site investigations over coming months.

	A range of technical field surveys and investigations are underway in September and
	October around the dam and upstream surrounding the Lake Dalrymple. Findings will feed into the Burdekin Falls Dam Raising EIS
	A prioritised schedule of geotechnical investigations is being agreed.
	• Instrumentation has been installed in the dam wall to collect data to assist with the next phase of design.
	Work ongoing to identify additional potential clay sources for the projects
	 Finalising the preliminary design report for the detailed business case.
