

Sustainability Policy

The Rookwood Weir Alliance, comprising of representatives from Sunwater, GHD, McCosker and Acciona will deliver the Rookwood Weir Project and achieve an 'excellent' Infrastructure Sustainability (IS) Rating. The IS rating is developed and assessed by the Infrastructure Sustainability Council of Australia (ISCA) both of which provide guidance and tools to complement the environmental and sustainability frameworks of individual Alliance Partners. Achieving a 'excellent' IS rating demonstrates a commitment to sustainable development and collaboration of all parties engaged to design, construct and deliver the Project.

The Alliance makes a commitment to continually improve the design and delivery aspects of the Project with an intent of achieving positive impacts within the construction footprint, the adjoining environment and the wider community.

The Alliance commits to:

- mitigating environmental, social and economic impacts
- respecting and valuing the natural environment and enhance biodiversity.
- working with the local community to leave a positive legacy
- investigating and employ clean energy options
- considering sustainability aspects in the procurement process
- promoting workforce development opportunities
