

Interruption to water supply in sections of the Bundaberg channel system

Isis Main Channel Surface Water System

25th August 2021

Sunwater will be undertaking routine weed control in sections of the Bundaberg channel system over the coming weeks. While this work is underway, water in these areas will be unavailable as a public safety precaution.

Sunwater customers and the general public who are supplied with or use water from the following areas must cease use during these days and times:

- Isis Main Channel from the Gregory River to Quart Pot Creek Pump Station namely outlets IMC0014, IMC0015, IMC0016, IMC0017, IMC0018, IMC0020A & IMC0020B
- 7:00am Tuesday 14 September 2021 until 12:00pm Friday 17 September 2021

Owners should advise their lessees of the shutdown details and customers should ensure they have adequate storage during this period.

Irrigators are requested to cease pumping at the above times for their respective areas. This will prevent pipelines from being drained and reduce the possibility of having to refill these lines.

Sunwater uses a red dye during channel treatments to show that the water should not be used. When injected into muddied waters the dye can become hard to see. To improve visibility, blue or green dye will be used for particularly muddied channels in future treatments.

Please note, these dates may alter due to current and forecasted weather conditions and/or customer demand.
